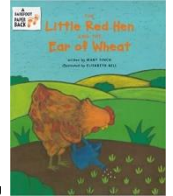
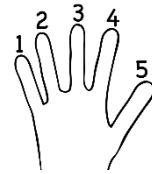

Welly Wednesday

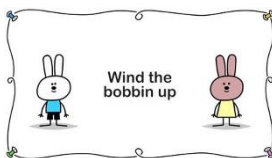
