What can go in the boxes.....

WHAT CAN GO IN MY SHOEBOX? Please choose a selection of items from those suggested below (more ideas are available on the website) but please do not include anything from the 'NO' list. Items should be new, however pre-loved items in good condition are acceptable.

For boys or girls: Toothbrush & toothpaste, hair accessories/ brush, soap & face cloth, stationery & paper, gloves, hat & scarf, new socks/underwear, a soft toy, game, puzzle, small musical instruments, toy vehicles, small ball, sweets (use by date from June), a photo and message from yourself.

The Home box: Candles, cooking utensils (no knives), plastic containers, t-towels, washing up cloths, hairbrush, small toiletries, bowls & cups, small Christmas decoration, soap, clothes pegs, headscarves, new socks and underwear, jewellery, new makeup.

NO: Food (only exception is sweets), medicines, military themed items, aerosols or anything highly flammable, sharp items, novels.
