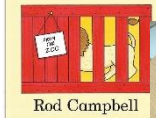


What have we been up to this week?

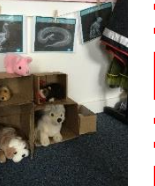

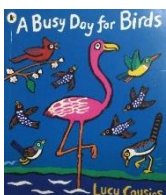
